**Monday, August 24 – Lake Siskiyou Resort**

Hike 3.6 miles (RT) to summit of Gray Butte near Mt. Shasta  
Have lunch at Yaks Café in Mount Shasta City  
Explore Mt. Shasta City Park  
    Drink from the headwaters of the Sacramento River  
Visit Mt. Shasta Sissen Museum  
Sip wine down by Lake Siskiyou  
Camp at Lake Siskiyou Resort

**Tuesday, August 25 – Lake Siskiyou Resort**

Drive to Castle Lake  
Hike 3 miles (RT) to Heart Lake  
Kayak 2.1 miles around Castle Lake  
Camp at Lake Siskiyou Resort

**Wednesday, August 26 –Redding and Petaluma (285 miles; 5.5 hours)**

Drive towards Petaluma  
Stop in Redding to see the Sundial Bridge  
Camp at Petaluma KOA

**Thursday, August 27 – Petaluma and San Francisco**

Hang out at Baker Beach – beautiful, warm sunny day  
Rock climb with the boys and Celeste at Planet Granite  
Takeout pizza from Pizzetta  
Camp at Petaluma KOA

Explore Donner Memorial State Park  
    Emigrant Museum - watch movie  
    Rainbow Bridge  
    Snowshed Tunnels  
    Checkout School Rock and Snowshed Wall climbing areas  
Drive down to King's Beach  
Walk around historic Truckee  
Lolo goes for a 5-mile run from campground on dirt roads to Reservoir – gets lost  
Andrew, Tommy, and Celeste arrive late
